

Scott Robinson - Biography

Scott Robinson has been employed as Port Director for the Muskogee City-County Port Authority since July of 1990, his primary responsibility being the management and development of the Port of Muskogee, located at the headwaters of the Arkansas River portion of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System.

Scott has served, at one time or another, on a variety of waterway related boards and commissions including the Arkansas Basin Development Association, the Arkansas Oklahoma Port Operator's Association, the Oklahoma Waterways Advisory Board and the Arkansas River Historical Society. Scott currently serves as Chairman of the National Waterways Conference.

Prior to becoming Port Director, Scott spent seventeen years as an independent oil and gas producer with operations in Oklahoma and Texas, and was an active member of the Oklahoma Independent Petroleum Association and the Independent Petroleum Association of America.

Scott attended the University of Oklahoma, graduating in 1971 with a bachelor's degree in Political Science. He is married to Julie and the father of five children ages 11 to 29.
